Frick Lane, a History Walk-Way

After more than a year of planning, the work is underway on Frick Lane. Designed by historian, Bob Waterman, the goal is to create an enhanced lane that provides some of the early history of Langley. Five panels will be installed that tell the story through photos and words. Two antique lamp are to be added and the lights in the blue glass arch replaced to illuminate the lane. New plants will enhance the lane thanks to a \$200 grant from the Whidbey Island Garden Club.

The pads for the panels and lights were poured thanks to the expert
